Dear Mr. Dilworth and Mr. Cohn,

Let this letter serve as notice that the Social Science History Association (herein "Association") wishes to discontinue its participation with Duke University Press in publishing its journal *Social Science History* as established in the Editing and Publishing Agreement for *Social Science History* made April 16, 1996 (herein "Agreement"). The Association is notifying Duke University Press that the Agreement shall not be automatically renewed after the conclusion of calendar year 2013. In order to allow time for devising alternative arrangements, we are providing Duke University Press with this notice before July 1, 2012, in order to take effect at the end of the 2013 volume of *Social Science History*.

The Association expects that the day-to-day publishing of *Social Science History* will continue without interruption or delay through the 2012 and 2013 volumes pursuant to the Agreement. Further, the Association expects to be paid its share of membership dues and editorial operations without interruption or delay pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.
